





SAT VS ACT

<p>Score Range: 400 - 1600</p> <p><i>Each test section is scored 200 - 800 (the reading and writing sections are combined)</i></p> <p>Penalties: No penalty or point deductions for wrong or blank answers.</p>	 <p>SCORING</p>	<p>Range: 1 - 36</p> <p><i>Each writing domain is scored 2 - 12</i></p> <p>Penalties: No penalty or point deductions for wrong or blank answers.</p>
